
# even if...

### faith in the midst of life's "what if" moments




#### Genesis 12:1-4 (NLT)

:: Even if we can't, HE CAN.


:: Even if we don't, HE DOES.

#### How to start a relationship with God:

  - :: What do you think made either choice easy or hard for him?
  - :: What were factors that led Abraham to step on his own?

  - :: Share a time you saw faith demonstrated. [you/others]
  - :: As you reflect on your life, what has defined your faith most?
- :: What current situations in your life are you most tempted to focus on "what if..." rather than "even if..."?
- :: What is one thing you need to do to shift from "what if..." to "even if..."?
- :: Identify 1 person you can ask to pray for you as you start to do that.
