WEEK 5 – THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

John 8:12

Jesus spoke to the people once more and said, "I am the light of the world. If you follow me, you won't have to walk in darkness, because you will have the light that leads to life."

Our willingness to **FOLLOW** is rooted in our ability to **TRUST**.

Exodus 13:21-22

By day the Lord went ahead of them in a pillar of cloud to guide them on their way and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so that they could travel by day or night. ²²Neither the pillar of cloud by day nor the pillar of fire by night left its place in front of the people.

1 John 1:5-7

This is the message we heard from Jesus and now declare to you: God is light, and there is no darkness in him at all. ⁶ So we are lying if we say we have fellowship with God but go on living in spiritual darkness; we are not practicing the truth. ⁷ But if we are living in the light, as God is in the light, then we have fellowship with each other, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, cleanses us from all sin.

No area of darkness can withstand Jesus' **TRANSFORMING** light.

John 8:9-11

At this, those who heard began to go away one at a time, the older ones first, until only Jesus was left, with the woman still standing there. ¹⁰ Jesus straightened up and asked her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one

condemned you?” ¹¹ “No one, sir,” she said. “Then neither do I condemn you,” Jesus declared. “Go now and leave your life of sin.”

John 9:1-5

As Jesus was walking along, he saw a man who had been blind from birth.

² “Rabbi,” his disciples asked him, “why was this man born blind? Was it because of his own sins or his parents’ sins?”

³ “It was not because of his sins or his parents’ sins,” Jesus answered. “This happened so the power of God could be seen in him. ⁴ We must quickly carry out the tasks assigned us by the one who sent us. The night is coming, and then no one can work. ⁵ But while I am here in the world, **I am** the light of the world.”

John 1:4-5

The Word gave life to everything that was created, and his life brought light to everyone. ⁵ The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness can never extinguish it.

Pursing Jesus leads to a RADIANT life.

Matthew 5:14-16

“You are the light of the world—like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden.

¹⁵ No one lights a lamp and then puts it under a basket. Instead, a lamp is placed on a stand, where it gives light to everyone in the house. ¹⁶ In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father.

 - :: What stands out to you most in Jesus’ words?
 - :: Discuss some of the implications of Jesus identifying himself as “the Light of the world.”
 - :: How might those things impact the way we live or relate to Him today?
- :: How do you think our willingness to follow God is related to our trust in Him?
- :: Share about a time when you or someone you know displayed significant trust in following Jesus’ leading even when they couldn’t see the final destination?
- :: Pastor Justin said, “No area of darkness can withstand Jesus’ transforming light.” How do you see this displayed in John 8:1-11 and 1 John 1:5-7?
- :: Why do you think many refuse to invite Jesus into the dark areas of their lives?
- :: Re-read Matthew 5:14-16. What do you think Jesus means when He tells His followers that they are the light of the world?
- :: Take a moment to do any honest assessment of your life.
 - :: Are there area(s) where you’re not trusting Jesus to lead?
 - :: Is there an area of darkness in you that you need to invite Jesus into?
 - :: How radiant is your life for God’s glory? Can others see Jesus’ light?
- :: Read Revelation 22:5. Jesus was the Light of the world when He came. He will be the light for all of eternity. What is one area that you need to let Him be the Light in your life today?
- :: Identify one person you can ask to pray for you as you step out and do that.
