The resurrection changes **EVERYTHING!**

Acts 1:8

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere – in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

The Great I AM RESIDES in us!

Romans 8:14-16

For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God. So you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when he adopted you as his own children. Now we call him, 'Abba, Father.'

For his Spirit joins with our spirit to affirm that we are God's children.

I AM **DEFINES** who WE ARE.

Romans 8:11

The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead, he will give life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you. (Romans 8:11, NLT)

We are **CARRIERS** of resurrection power!

"The hope... was not for a rescue operation that would snatch Israel (or humans or the faithful) FROM the world, but for a rescue operation that would be FOR the world, an operation through which redeemed humans would play once more the role for which they were designed. It was the hope for a renewed world in which justice and mercy would reign forever." (N.T. Wright)

Dear Lord Jesus, I know I am a sinner, and I ask for Your forgiveness.

I believe You died for my sins and rose from the dead. Today, I receive you as my Savior; and I put my faith in you as my LORD. Help me to look to you and follow you all the days of my life.

 - :: To whom can you begin to share the message of Jesus? (Like the "big, blonde guy" from Murphy's story)
