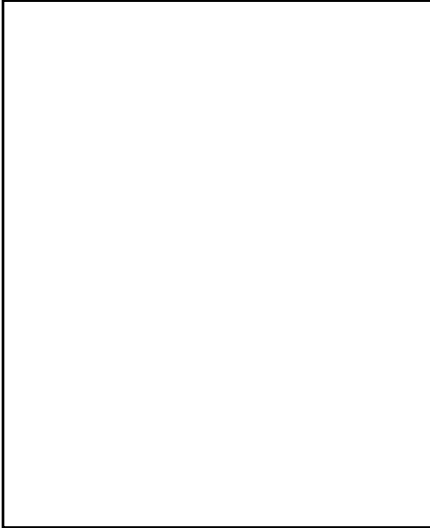

**We will never prevail because WE ARE ABLE,
but because WE ARE AVAILABLE.**

James 2:14-26

What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save them? ¹⁵ Suppose a brother or a sister is without clothes and daily food. ¹⁶ If one of you says to them, "Go in peace; keep warm and well fed," but does nothing about their physical needs, what good is it? ¹⁷ In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.

¹⁸ But someone will say, "You have faith; I have deeds."

Show me your faith without deeds, and I will show you my faith by my deeds. ¹⁹ You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that—and shudder. ²⁰ You foolish person, do you want evidence that faith without deeds is useless? ²¹ Was not our father Abraham considered righteous for what he did when he offered his son Isaac on the altar? ²² You see that his faith and his actions were working together, and his faith was made complete by what he did. ²³ And the scripture was fulfilled that says, "Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness," and he was called God's friend. ²⁴ You see that a person is considered righteous by what they do and not by faith alone. ²⁵ In the same way, was not even Rahab the prostitute considered righteous for what she did when she gave lodging to the spies and sent them off in a different direction? ²⁶ As the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without deeds is dead.

Faith alone saves, but saving faith is never **ALONE**.

SO WHAT?

Where has God positioned you to live in
the **POWER** of the resurrection?

How to start a relationship with God:

- 1) Admitting that you, like everyone else, are in need of rescue.
- 2) Asking God to forgive your sins.
- 3) Saying YES to God by trusting Jesus as Savior & Lord.

You can do that right now by simply talking to God in a prayer like this:

**Dear Lord Jesus, I know I am a sinner, and I ask for Your forgiveness.
I believe You died for my sins and rose from the dead. Today, I receive you as my
Savior; and I put my faith in you as my LORD. Help me to look to you and follow
you all the days of my life.
In Your name, Amen.**

:: Discuss the meaning and implications of that reality.

:: What role does Holy Spirit play in them? What is our role?

:: Revisit James 2:14-26.

:: What is your understanding or how faith and deeds intersect?

:: Identify one way you have/haven’t lived out a faith that “works.”

:: Identify one area of your life where Jesus has positioned you to live in the power of His resurrection. What do you need to do this week to take a next step toward that opportunity/invitation?

RIVER FLOODING UPDATE:

As many of you are aware, flooding in the Quad Cities has reached historic levels; and BridgePointe485, our Heritage Network Hub [former Kone Building], has now been surrounded by water.

Significant rain, unprecedented water from municipal drains & record river levels created a “not so” perfect storm that breached our barriers this past Tuesday. The flooding didn’t come directly from the river, but rather from the opposite direction along city streets & drains that were overwhelmed with river water. Ultimately, the municipal infrastructure just couldn’t keep up, and we couldn’t absorb it all.

Although not the outcome we wanted & worked for, we are grateful. Everyone is safe. No one was hurt, and we are expectant that God will use this for His glory.

Many of you have asked what you can do. The first is pray.

:: Pray the waters recede quickly.

:: Pray for rain to stop.

:: Pray also for the City of Davenport. It’s been even more challenging for our friends across the river.
