⁹ "As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. ¹⁰ If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in his love.

Intensity comes from **PROXIMITY**.

So What?

Evidences of Authentic Love:

- Speak the truth in love.
- Consistently seek more FOR others than FROM them.
- Live in a posture of genuine empathy.

Evidences of Intense Spirituality:

- Seek God and His priorities first.
- Live lives marked by the character & love of Christ.
- Consistently invest/sacrifice for others.

Prayer of the People

How to start a relationship with God:

- 1) Admitting that you, like everyone, are in need of rescue.
- 2) Asking God to forgive your sins.
- 3) Saying <u>YES</u> to God by trusting Jesus as Savior & Lord.

You can do that right now by simply talking to God in a prayer like this:

Dear Lord Jesus, I know I am a sinner, and I ask for Your forgiveness. I believe You died for my sins and rose from the dead. Today, I receive you as my Savior; and I put my faith in you as my LORD. Help me to look to you and follow you all the days of my life. In Your name, Amen.
