We are people of hope!

Because...

Romans 15:13

Holy Spirit enables us to be BETTER.

Romans 8:1-2

Galatians 5:22-23

But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.

Holy Spirit enables us to be BIGGER.

1 Corinthians 12:4-7

There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the same Spirit is the source of them all. There are different kinds of service, but we serve the same Lord. God works in different ways, but it is the same God who does the work in all of us.

A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other.

Holy Spirit enables us to be **BOLDER.**

Acts 4:31

After this prayer, the meeting place shook, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit. Then they preached the word of God with boldness.

Holy Spirit enables us to be **BRIGHTER.**

1 Corinthians 2:10-12

But it was to us that God revealed these things by his Spirit. For his Spirit searches out everything and shows us God's deep secrets. No one can know a person's thoughts except that person's own spirit, and no one can know God's thoughts except God's own Spirit. And we have received God's Spirit (not the world's spirit), so we can know the wonderful things that God has freely given to us.

"The Spirit-saturated person has Spiritual Intelligence. By the Spirit, that person comprehends the incomprehensible; by the Spirit, that person embraces what was previously unembraceable; by the Spirit, that person sees into her or his heart to a depth previously obstructed." (Scot McKnight)

How to start a relationship with God:

:: Consider all three weeks of this Hope in the Dark journey. How did God encourage or challenge you?
