




## James 1:19-20 (NIV)

## How to receive forgiveness from God:

- 1) Admit you, like everyone else, need new LIFE in Jesus.

- 3) Receive new LIFE from God by trusting in Jesus as your Savior & Lord.

## You can do that right now by simply talking to God in a prayer like this:

Dear Lord Jesus, I know I am a sinner, and I ask for Your forgiveness.

I believe You died for my sins and rose from the dead. Today, I receive you as my Savior; and I put my faith in you as my LORD. Help me to live for you all the days of my life. In Your name, Amen.

## For Further Reflection:

- :: Take a moment to identify some of the circles of relationship you currently have? What makes them valuable? What can make them challenging?
- :: Reread James 1:19-20. Which action is most difficult for you to live into? Which is easiest? Why do you think that is?
- :: Read Galatians 5:22-23. Which fruit of the Holy Spirit is most evident in your life? Which is least evident?
- :: Think of a relationship circle that was/is broken in your life. How did that happen? What would you want to do differently if you could? What might God be asking you to do next?
- :: Identify an area of your life God is inviting you seek understanding. What is one thing you can do this week that will position you to do so?
- :: Ask someone you trust to pray for you as you seek to take that next step.
