



# 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 (MSG)

<sup>23-24</sup> May God himself, the God who makes everything holy and whole, make you holy and whole, put you together—spirit, soul, and body—and keep you fit for the coming of our Master, Jesus Christ. The One who called you is completely dependable. If he said it, he'll do it!

### Isaiah 61:1-4 (NIV)

<sup>1</sup> The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me. because the Lord has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted. to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners, <sup>2</sup> to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn. <sup>3</sup> and provide for those who grieve in Zion to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes. the oil of joy instead of mourning. and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair. They will be called oaks of righteousness. a planting of the Lord for the display of his splendor. <sup>4</sup> They will rebuild the ancient ruins and restore the places long devastated;

that have been devastated for generations

they will renew the ruined cities

Sawubona: a Zulu term, means, "I see you."

## 2 Corinthians 13:11 (NIV)

## How to receive forgiveness from God:

- :: Ask someone you trust to pray for you as you seek to take that next step.
