


Church: (ekklesia) [Greek] - "called out ones"

The Bible tells us of what <u>WAS</u>, <u>IS</u> and <u>IS TO COME</u>.



John 3:16 [NIV]

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

John 1:12 [NIV]

Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God.

Acts 1:7-8 [NIV]

⁷ He said to them: "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. ⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Being the church is less about what we can <u>GET</u> & more about who we can <u>BECOME</u>.

How to receive forgiveness from God:

- 1) Admit you, like everyone else, need new LIFE in Jesus.
- 2) Ask God to forgive your sins by the sacrifice of Jesus.
- 3) Receive new LIFE from God by trusting in Jesus as your Savior & Lord.

You can do that now by simply talking to God in a prayer like this:

Dear Lord Jesus, I know I am a sinner, and I ask for Your forgiveness.

I believe You died for my sins and rose from the dead. Today, I receive you as my Savior; and I put my faith in you as my LORD. Help me to live for you all the days of my life. In Your name, Amen.

For Further Reflection:

- :: How would you describe the purpose(mission) of the church [ekklesia] that Jesus established?
- :: What do you find most exciting/daunting about that?
- :: How would you assess/evaluate your engagement in his church and the related purpose(s)?
- :: How would you describe the role the Bible plays in your
- daily life? What do you need to continue? What might you need to change?
- :: Take a moment to review the "grand narrative" that Pastor Shawn shared.
 - :: What stood out to you most as you reflected on it? Why? :: What did you find most helpful, or challenging, in comparing and contrasting the two halves of the greater journey?
- :: Pastor Shawn said, "Being the church is less about what we can get & more about who we can become."
 - :: What are some practical implications about that reality?
 - :: What happens if we try to live in reverse? [i.e. seek to get more than become.]
 - :: What are tangible ways we can focus on becoming over getting?
- :: Read Acts 1:7-8
 - :: What part of this passage stirs your heart/mind most? Why?
 - :: How might the Lord want you to live differently this week as a result?
- :: Identify 1 thing God is inviting you to more fully "be the church" this week, & do it.
