TRAP: What authority does Jesus have to enter Jerusalem as King to cleanse the Temple and teach as the High Priest?

"Let me ask you a question first," he replied. "Did John's authority to baptize come from heaven, or was it merely human?" They talked it over among themselves. So they finally replied that they didn't know. And Jesus responded, "Then I won't tell you by what authority I do these things." [Luke 20:3-8 NLT]
