BACKSTORY OF COLOSSIANS (Colossians 1:1-2)

- **Writer:** Paul with Timothy
- **Written:** AD 60-61 while Paul was under house arrest and waiting for a hearing before Caesar. (Acts 28:16-31)
- **Reason:** The church at Colosse was under attack from false teachers who were slandering the deity of Jesus Christ.
- **Resolution:** The preeminent and all sufficient Christ is the center of all things. He is God, Creator, Savior, and sovereign over all things.
